Details

- Machinery is permitted to operate between 08:00hrs to 17:30hrs Monday to Friday and 08:00hrs to 13:00hrs on Saturdays.
- No construction to be carried out on Sundays and public holidays.
- Deliveries and muck away will be permitted between 09:30 to 15:30 Monday to Friday only, to avoid peak travel times and school pick up / drop off.
- Site traffic will utilise a temporary construction access off Cambridge Road in the same location as the approved full access.
- Construction traffic will enter Barkway from the A10 onto The Joint, before turning onto Royston Road and heading along the southern boundary of site before turning onto Cambridge Road to reach the access. This is shown on appendix C.
- This removes the need for construction traffic to go through Barkway High Street where the greatest amount of traffic and parked vehicles are present. It also removes the need to travel through neighbouring villages such as Barley.
- The infrastructure will be initially installed on site for a period of up to 16 weeks. The works will include construction of the bell mouth access and Sales Area consisting of 3 units and associated parking area.
- Following on from this the site access on Cambridge Road will be limited to sales only and the construction access will run from the side of Royston Road. The construction traffic will follow the same initial route as it has to the initial access however will turn off into site on Royston Road rather than continuing on around the south of the site.
